Beginning on October 7, 2020 the WSU Extension King County Master Gardener Program will launch its **third season of Growing Groceries classes**. Past seasons have helped over 500 home gardeners learn how to grow healthy food using sustainable gardening techniques.

The series will be taught entirely online and consists of twelve unique classes running from October 2020 through May 2021. Classes are ideal for the beginner to intermediate home gardener and are open to the public. Our Master Gardener faculty teaches scientific gardening practices suited for our Western Washington climate.

The early portion of the series provides background on essential gardening skills while later classes focus on major vegetable and small fruit categories. Content is taught at the time of year when it can be applied in the garden.

Advance registration is required for each class — suggested minimum donation is \$5 per session. Registration fees support the Master Gardener Foundation of King County and the WSU Extension King County Master Gardener Program.
